# Audi Technology



## Audi Multi Media Interface

Audi's Multi Media Interface (MMI) is an integral operating concept for fitted vehicle and infotainment components. The MMI control knob in the centre console links to a high-mounted MMI display in the dash and controls entertainment, communication, information, and vehicle systems in a simple and intuitive manner via the single main knob and the eight function keys grouped around it. The new generation MMI touch system will be available in the new Audi A3, Audi A7 Sportback and Audi A8 ranges. With the integration of the MMI touch the user is given a new and unique way of operating the MMI Navigation Plus with ease, without needing to divert their eyes from the road ahead. It supports handwritten inputs of letters and digits, for ease of entering phone numbers or navigation destinations.

## Audi Drive Select

Audi Drive Select is a standard feature on the Audi A3 SE and quattro®, Audi A6, Audi A7 Sportback, Audi A8 and optional on Audi A4, Audi A5, Audi Q3, Audi Q5 and Audi Q7, which enables you to set the driving characteristics of your car to your preference. There are three settings: Comfort, for the smoothest ride; Auto, the optimum setup for prevailing driving conditions; and Dynamic, for sporty driving. If the vehicle is fitted with the optional Satellite Navigation Plus, a fourth Individual setting becomes available. This allows drivers to tune the car exactly to their needs.

## TDI Performance Diesel Technology

Minimising emissions and maximising fuel economy without sacrificing power and performance are essential to Audi Technology. With this in mind, Audi has developed TDI performance diesel technology, with its piezo injection system operating at up to 1,600 bar, delivering fuel in precise bursts for efficient combustion.

## Audi connect

Audi connect pools all the applications and developments designed to connect current and future Audi models with the Internet, their owners and their surroundings. This state-of-the-art technology is available in Audi A4, Audi A5, Audi A6, Audi A7 Sportback, Audi A8 and Audi Q7.

Audi connect offers features such as navigation with Google Earth and Google Street View, online weather forecasts and Audi traffic information that are sent to the vehicle via 3G. Audi connect links assistance systems with each other. In this way, Audi connect interacts with the transmission system, lights and adaptive cruise control with Stop&Go function or adaptive light, even with the navigation system deactivated. Audi connect is only available with the optional Audi MMI Navigation plus system.

## S/SE/quattro®

S, SE and quattro® are new equipment lines that replace Attraction, Ambition and Ambiente, respectively. These lines were introduced with the Audi A4 range and will filter through to all the models as new models are introduced. The S, SE and quattro® lines take into consideration customer feedback and reduce the current complexity of the Audi range while meeting and exceeding expectations.





### **Audi quattro® Permanent All-Wheel Drive**

Audi are pioneers in four-wheel drive technology by being the creators of quattro® permanent all-wheel drive - a system that delivers superb handling and traction, while giving extra security and stability on wet or low-grip surfaces. The latest models feature 40/60 percent distribution of power front to rear for optimum handling, while asymmetric/dynamic torque distribution to all wheels enables optimum safety by automatically adjusting to variations in grip within a fraction of a second. Audi is presenting a new, evolutionary stage of its permanent all-wheel drive system for longitudinal engines in the high-performance RS 5 Coupé - the quattro® drive with self-locking crown gear differential and torque vectoring. With an extremely broad torque distribution range, the crown-gear centre differential surpasses its predecessors with grip that becomes even better.

### **Audi Start/stop System**

Efficiency comes standard in every Audi, and our Start/stop system is an example of this. A standard feature on the Audi A1, Audi A3, Audi A3 Sportback, Audi Q3, Audi A7 Sportback range, Audi A4, Audi A5 and selected Audi Q5 models at no additional cost, this innovative system is the first of its kind in the premium car segment in South Africa. When your vehicle comes to a stop, you put the gear lever into neutral and remove your foot from the clutch pedal. The engine will switch off automatically, and an indicator light will illuminate in the display. When you are ready to drive off, simply press the clutch pedal and the engine will restart. All you have to do is select first gear and release the clutch. The Start/stop system lowers fuel consumption by 0.2 litres per 100km and reduces CO<sub>2</sub> emissions by around 5g/km. A class-leading innovation from Audi that will save a lot in the long run, so you and the environment can breathe easy.



### **Audi Side Assist**

Optional Audi Side Assist monitors the area behind the car using radar sensors located in the rear bumper - and warns you via a visual signal mounted in the door mirror if there is a vehicle approaching in your blind spot.

The five-cylinder turbo generated 232 kW (315 hp) from a displacement of 2.2 litres, accelerating the RS 2 Avant from a standstill to 100 km/h in just 5.4 seconds and onward to a top speed of 262 km/h. Porsche AG, which functioned as development and production partner, delivered parts such as brakes and wheels.

The first car from quattro® GmbH. The Audi S6 plus did not yet bear the RS badge, but it was nevertheless the first model to be manufactured by quattro® GmbH. It had a 4.2-litre V8 with an output of 240 kW (326 hp) and a six-speed manual gearbox. The standard sprint was dealt with in 5.6 seconds. Although the S6 plus was also available as a sedan, the majority of customers opted for the Avant.

Compact displacement, lots of power. There was a cooperation partner involved in the first RS 4 Avant, too – in the form of the recently integrated Cosworth Technology Ltd. Together with quattro® GmbH, the English firm lifted the output of the 2.7-litre V6 biturbo to 279 kW (380 hp); the result was a zero to 100 sprint of 4.9 seconds. Demand for the RS 4 Avant was so high that Audi had to double the production volumes originally planned.

The business class saw the Audi RS 6 make its debut in 2002 – available as both sedan and Avant. Its 4.2-litre V8, complete with two turbochargers, produced 331 kW (450 hp); Cosworth handled the assembly of the five-valve engine. With its standard five-speed Tiptronic, the Audi RS 6 accelerated from zero to 100 km/h in 4.7 seconds. Meanwhile, Dynamic Ride Control (DRC) celebrated its premiere in the running gear. The RS 6 plus followed in 2004, producing an output of 353 kW (480 hp) and an electronically limited top speed of 280 km/h.

The second generation of the RS 4 appeared in 2005 – first as a sedan and Avant and later also as a cabriolet. Drive was supplied by the all-new, high-revving V8 with a displacement of 4.2 litres. The direct-injection, naturally aspirated unit generated 309 kW (420 hp). The RS 4 Sedan catapulted from zero to 100 km/h in 4.8 seconds. Further technology highlights included quattro® drive with the then new asymmetrical dynamic torque distribution and optional carbon-fiber reinforced ceramic brakes.

The 2008 RS 6 was the most powerful series-production Audi built to-date. Its V10 biturbo with a displacement of 5.0 litres produced 426 kW (580 hp) – enough for a standard sprint of 4.6 seconds and a top speed of 280 km/h. The two ‘plus’ equipment lines that followed in 2010 achieved a top speed of 303 km/h. A fast-shifting, six-speed tiptronic sent the driving force to the quattro® driveline. The second-generation RS 6 was available as a sedan and Avant.

With the RS 3 Sportback, Audi took the RS philosophy into the premium compact class. The drivetrain featured an extremely reliable seven-speed S tronic and a hydraulic multi-plate clutch. The RS 3 Sportback accelerated from zero to 100 km/h in 4.6 seconds. Fenders made from carbon-fiber reinforced polymer (CFRP) bore testimony to the ultra-lightweight design expertise of quattro® GmbH.

# Audi R8 Spyder

The lid of the stowage compartment that holds the soft top is made from carbon-fiber reinforced polymer (CFRP), as are the side panels. As in the Coupé, the seven-speed S tronic and the quattro® drivetrain were conceived specifically for the mid-engine concept; depending on the driving situation, the viscous coupling sends from 15 to 30 percent of torque to the front axle.
